

Hints for PR2

Some of you have asked how to get started on PR2b. Have you tried compiling the code from Dr. Abel using “make”?

If you “make” the Haskell code (direct link <http://www.cse.chalmers.se/edu/year/2018/course/DAT151/laborations/lab2/lab2-stub-haskell.tar.gz>), you will find that it compiles. If you then try it out on a file (e.g., dont-bind-too-eagerly.cc) from the test suite (direct link: <http://www.cse.chalmers.se/edu/year/2018/course/DAT151/laborations/lab2/testsuite/lab2-testsuite.tar.gz>), you will get something like this:

```
PS> .\lab2 .\dont-bind-too-eagerly.cc  
  
no interpreter yet
```

One good way to do this assignment is to fill in typechecker.hs and interpreter.hs, which are just stubs in the package from Dr. Abel.

Note that to unpack a tar archive, you need to run the tar program. If you are using Windows, PowerShell includes it, and `tar -xvf <filename>` works well.
